This meeting of the Arizona Independent 9 Redistricting Commission will now come to order. 10 Today is Monday, December 14, 2015, and the time 11 is 5:15 p.m. 12 If everyone would please rise, I would like to 13 ask Vice-Chair Freeman to lead us in the Pledge of 14 Allegiance. 15 (Whereupon, the Pledge of Allegiance was 16 recited.) 17 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Great. Thank you. 18 If we could go ahead with roll call. 19 Vice-Chair Freeman. 20 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: Here. 21 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Commissioner Kallen. 22 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: Present. 23 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Commissioner McNulty. 24 COMMISSIONER MCNULTY: Here. 25 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Commissioner Stertz. © AZ Litigation Support, LLC (480)481-0649 www.CourtReportersAz.com

COMMISSIONER STERTZ: Here. 1 2 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: We have a quorum. Other participants in today's meeting I 3 understand include our sitting director, Ray Bladine. 4 5 RAY BLADINE: Yes. CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Kristina Gomez, our deputy 6 7 executive director. 8 We have legal counsel, participating in the room, 9 Joe Kanefield and Kristin Windtberg, and then on the phone 10 Mary O'Grady. 11 And then we also have other staff for the IRC, 12 Ana Garcia and Lisa Schmelling. 13 Our court reporter today is Kate Roundy. 14 And we have video being taken by 15 Eric Schenefield. 16 Anybody else? Is there anyone else on the staff 17 that I missed or on the phone? 18 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: Colleen, it's Scott. Nobody 19 else on the staff. 20 We do have four members of the public here as 21 well, and if you want to consider that and where we sort 22 of slot the anticipated executive session. 23 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Great. Thanks. 24 This brings us then to the second item on the 25 agenda.

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Looking at the agenda, I guess, you know, if we wanted to, I don't know if it makes sense for Mr. Bladine or Ms. Garcia to give their executive director's report, because we do have a legal briefing as the second item, which will likely mean the Commission going into executive session.

7 Mr. Bladine, do you have any thoughts on that? 8 RAY BLADINE: I think it would be nice for the 9 public to go ahead and take the executive director's 10 report. Vice-Chair Freeman had suggested that earlier, 11 too, and it won't take us very long, and Kristina will 12 present it.

13 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Great.

Everyone should have received a number of attachments that were sent out to the Commissioners, so I assume you will be going by those.

17 KRISTINA GOMEZ: Yes.

18 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Great. Thanks, Kristina.

19 KRISTINA GOMEZ: Sure.

20 Madam Chair, Commission members, first of all, I 21 would like to go through the budget.

This is the spreadsheet that's titled Fiscal Year And this is the monthly expenditure report that is forwarded to the Commission each month.

25 So in November, you can see we spent a total of

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1 \$167,098.

Two items in December, the item for \$9 and for 2 \$70, those were accidentally taken from the wrong fiscal 3 year. Those were two FY '15 bills that came in at the 4 5 very last minute. So the State Board's Office went ahead and they made those adjustments. So you will see next 6 7 month that those two bills will be taken out of FY '15. 8 And also, too, you will also notice in June, 9 under Professional and Outside Services, the remaining 10 balance there is \$1.6 million. That's just the projection 11 that's left over from the combined FY '16 appropriation 12 and the supplemental as well. 13 And the second spreadsheet, it just shows the 14 adjustments for FY '15. So once again, those are bills 15 that came in at the very last minute from fiscal year '15. 16 Next, our office staff, we still have Ana Garcia 17 and Lisa Schmelling still with the office. 18 The big news with our office is we are finally in our new office space. So it looks pretty nice. 19 There's 20 no more rats, no more mice, no more mold, so we are happy 21 about that. And so far so good. We are still trying to 22 unpack some boxes, but we are doing well here. 23 The next item is technology. Buck has taken 24 another job in the private sector, so he won't be able to 25 join us as often. with this meeting. But Buck will still help with website,
 website postings, and any other technology issues with our
 agency.

4 And finally, the 2001 and 2010 records are back 5 with Library and Archives. So they were happy to have their records back, and we were happy to give them back. 6 7 And the current files for this Commission, they are all boxed up, and they are in Ray's office right now. 8 9 No, they are in Kristina's office. RAY BLADINE: 10 KRISTINA GOMEZ: But they are with us, so... 11 Any questions? 12 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Thank you, Ms. Garcia. 13 I just want to give a shout out to the Evans 14 House and thank it for its service. I understand the 15 State Historic Preservation Office is now taking over, but 16 I am still a big fan of that place, and I'm glad that it

17 served us well, rodents included.

18 Did anyone have any questions for Kristina?19 (No oral response.)

20 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. I'm not hearing any.21 Anything from Mr. Bladine?

22 RAY BLADINE: I might just comment briefly.

I think Kristina covered the budget in great detail, but, as you know, all of our legal expenses are starting to come in again. Kristina and I have reviewed

where we are. We believe that we will be fine this year.
 We have enough appropriation with the supplemental and
 this year's appropriation.

4 It's hard to know what will happen in the next 5 fiscal year. It depends on timing, if Harris ends up being still a case, and how fast things are proceeding in 6 Leach. But I think that sometime probably in February we 7 8 could see whether the -- normally we would get about 9 1.1 million a year. And it may be sufficient or it may 10 not, but clearly right now we are fine. So I would just 11 add that.

12 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Thank you.

13 Any questions for Mr. Bladine or on this agenda 14 item before we move on?

15 (No oral response.)

16 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Hearing none, thank 17 you very much, Ms. Garcia and Mr. Bladine, for all your 18 work and for getting us moved into the new space. We 19 appreciate it.

20 KRISTINA GOMEZ: Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. So we will go back - oh, I guess we could do public comment now too.

23 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: Madam Chair, it's

24 Scott Freeman.

25 I just sort of whispered to everyone who was here

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1 and asked them whether they were going to have any 2 comment, and I think everyone said no. So there you have 3 it.

4 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Thank you for doing 5 that.

Then we will go ahead and go back to agenda 6 item 2, which is legal briefing, discussion and possible 7 8 action relating to pending litigation in Leach versus 9 Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission, including 10 authorization of the expenditures pursuant to 11 A.R.S. 38-431.07(B). The commission may vote to go into 12 executive session, which will not be open to the public, 13 for the purpose of obtaining legal advice and providing 14 direction to counsel.

And with that, I apologize to the public in advance, but we will be likely doing this. But we will first see, I guess, if the Commission votes to do so. But I'm not sure how long we will be in. We have an estimated time of 30 minutes, and so people are welcome to stay in the vicinity if they would like to.

21 But can I first get a motion to go into executive 22 session?

23 COMMISSION MCNULTY: I move we go into executive24 session for the purposes of this agenda item.

25 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: And I second.

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CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Thank you. 1 The 2 motion has been seconded. 3 Any discussion? 4 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: Madam Chair, it's 5 Scott Freeman. 6 Go ahead, Mr. Freeman. CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: The only thing I would ask 7 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: 8 is whether there would be anything -- any update that 9 could be provided that would pertain to this agenda item 10 that would not be covered by executive session before we 11 go into executive session. 12 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: That's a good question. 13 Mary or Joe or Kristin, is there anything you 14 would like to say there? 15 JOSEPH KANEFIELD: Madam Chair, this is 16 Joe Kanefield. 17 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Go ahead, Joe. 18 JOSEPH KANEFIELD: Can everybody hear me okay? CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: 19 Yes. 20 JOSEPH KANEFIELD: So we can just give a very 21 quick update on the Leach case and where we are at. 22 You might recall that this case was stayed during 23 the duration of the U.S. Supreme Court proceedings in the 24 Arizona Legislature case. When that case was decided in 25 favor of the Commission, the stay was lifted and the case © AZ Litigation Support, LLC (480)481-0649

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1 resumed.

2 So at this point we are actively in the middle of 3 discovery, and that is where we are, unless there are any 4 questions.

5 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Questions for Mr. Kanefield?
6 KRISTINE WINDTBERG: Madam Chair, this is
7 Kristin Windtberg.

8 Before you do that, just for purposes of our 9 record, if everyone on the phone could say their names 10 before they start speaking, I think we are just having a 11 little bit of trouble hearing making sure that the record 12 is clear.

13 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Great. Will do.

14 KRISTIN WINDTBERG: Thank you.

15 CHAIRMAN MCNULTY: For the record, I made the 16 motion -- this is Linda McNulty. I made the motion to go 17 into executive session.

18 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: And for the record,

19 Commissioner Kallen, and I seconded the motion to go into 20 executive session.

21 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Any other discussion on this 22 motion?

23 (No oral response.)

24 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: All in favor?

25 COMMISSIONER MCNULTY: Aye.

1 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: Aye. 2 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: Aye. 3 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Aye. COMMISSIONER STERTZ: Aye. 4 5 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Any opposed? I think 6 I heard five ayes. 7 (No oral response.) 8 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Not hearing any, with 9 that, we will exit out of the public session. 10 The time is 5:28 p.m. 11 And I'm not sure what the arrangements are there, 12 Mr. Bladine, if you want to let me know when the public 13 has cleared. The time is 5:57 p.m. 6 Do we have any members of the public that stayed 7 with us? Just curious. 8 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: We have two. 9 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Oh, great. I'm glad. 10 Are there any motions that any commissioners 11 would like to propose coming out of executive session? 12 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: Yes, Madam Chair. This is 13 Commissioner Kallen. At this time I would like to move to authorize 14 15 the expenditure to defend the claim of violation of the 16 Statutory Open Meeting Law as raised in Leach v. IRC. 17 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Is there a second? 18 COMMISSIONER MCNULTY: I would second it. 19 Can I make just a clarification? 20 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Sure. 21 COMMISSIONER MCNULTY: That we authorize defense 22 of the Commission and its -- any of its officers or any of 23 its members. 24 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: I would amend my motion to 25 reflect that we were asking that it would be as a -- the © AZ Litigation Support, LLC (480)481-0649 www.CourtReportersAz.com

1 Commission as a body and the officer -- its officers, the 2 Commissioners as individuals as well. 3 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Thank you for that amended motion. 4 5 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: And, Madam Chair, Scott Freeman, just a point of clarification. 6 7 Its officers or its member, its commissioners, that is all inclusive. That would include all five 8 9 commissioners; correct? 10 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: That's my understanding. 11 Legal counsel, or I guess we can ask the people 12 who made the motion. 13 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: Yes, Madam Chair. This is Commissioner Kallen. 14 15 And, yes, it is intended that it would include 16 all five commissioners. 17 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Any discussion? 18 JOSEPH KANEFIELD: Madam Chair, this is Joe Kanefield. 19 20 I just want to clarify that this motion, as I 21 understand it, is being made in accordance with the 22 requirement in the Open Meeting Law, specifically A.R.S. 23 38-431.07(B). 24 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Is that accurate, 25 Mr. Kallen?

1 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: Yes, it is. 2 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. Any other discussion? 3 (No oral response.) CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: All in favor? 4 5 COMMISSIONER MCNULTY: Aye. 6 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: Ave. 7 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Aye. 8 VICE-CHAIR FREEMAN: Aye. 9 COMMISSIONER STERTZ: Aye. 10 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Any opposed? 11 (No oral response.) 12 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Okay. The motion carries unanimously. 13 14 Are there any other motions coming out of 15 executive session that anyone wants to propose? 16 COMMISSIONER MCNULTY: This is Linda. 17 I would move that we authorize counsel to proceed 18 with the motions that they specifically described to us in 19 executive session in accordance with their 20 recommendations. 21 CHAIRPERSON MATHIS: Is there a second? 22 COMMISSIONER KALLEN: Madam Chair, this is 23 Commissioner Kallen. And thanks for being here tonight. 22 And thank you, Kate, for being willing to stick 23 with us through this, and for all the staff's work tonight 24 and throughout the year.
