Pursuant to Article IV, Part 2, § (12) of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the Commissioners of the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission and the general public that the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission will hold a regular meeting open to the public on August 16, 2001 and, if it is necessary to recess that meeting, will hold a resumed public meeting on August 17, 2001. This meeting will be held beginning at 9:30 a.m. on August 16<sup>th</sup> and, if necessary, beginning at 8:00 a.m. on August 17<sup>th</sup> at The Doubletree Hotel at Reid Park, 445 S. Alvernon, Tucson, Arizona.

The Commission may vote to go into executive session, which will not be open to the public, for any item listed on the agenda, for the purpose of discussing personnel matters (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(1)), consulting with Commission attorneys, regarding pending or contemplated litigation (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(4)), or obtaining legal advice (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3)).

- IV. Possible executive session(s) for discussion or consultation for legal advice with the Commission's attorneys pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3).
- V. Discussion and possible decision concerning salary of Executive Director.
- VI. Public Comment. (Same guidelines as stated in agenda item II).
- VII. Future Commission Meeting(s).
- VIII. Recess or Adjournment.
