The agenda for the **Aug. 11, 2001**, portion of the meeting of the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission is amended by adding agenda item IX.

- III. Discussion and possible approval of the minutes of the Commission's July 17, 2001, public meeting.
- IV. Executive Director's report on current status and revisions, discussion and possible decision regarding the Commission's budget.
- V. Presentation and report by NDC concerning modified grids.
- VI. Possible executive session(s) for discussion or consultation for legal advice with the Commission's attorneys pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3).
- VII. Discussion and possible decision(s) concerning instructions to NDC on further modifications to the grids for development of draft congressional and legislative maps.
- VIII. Discussion and possible decision(s) concerning adoption of draft congressional and legislative district maps.
- IX. Presentation, discussion and possible decision(s) concerning the Commission's process during the thirty-day public comment period for items such as the release of draft plans, mailings, citizen kits and the procedure for responding to submissions. NOTE: This agenda item will be considered during that portion of the Commission's meeting to be held on Saturday, August 11, 2001.
- X. Public Comment. (Same guidelines as stated in agenda item II).
- XI. Future Commission Meeting(s).
- XII. Recess or Adjournment.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Commission meeting may be recessed in public session on Thursday, August 9, 2001, and Friday, August 10, 2001, and will be resumed on the following mornings of Friday, August 10, 2001, and Saturday, August 11, 2001, respectively, at the times and locations set forth herein. Before recessing, the Commission Chairman will state which portion of the foregoing agenda will be the agenda when the meeting resumes the following morning.
