Pursuant to Article IV, Part 2, § (12) of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the Commissioners of the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission and the general public that the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission will hold a meeting open to the public on August 13, 2002, at 9:30 a.m. at the Wyndham Buttes Resort, 2000 Westcourt Way, Tempe, Arizona. If it is necessary to recess that meeting, the Commission will hold a resumed public meeting on August 14, 2002 at no earlier than 8:00 a.m. at the same location.

The Commission may vote to go into executive session, which will not be open to the public, for any item listed on the agenda, for the purpose of discussing personnel matters (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(1)), consulting with Commission attorneys, regarding pending or contemplated litigation (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(4)), or obtaining legal advice (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3)).

The agenda is as follows:

- I.        Call to Order.
- II.      Public Comment.

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\* If the meeting resumes on this date, it will be at the time set by the chairman when the prior day's meeting is recessed. The time set will be no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and may be later.

This is the time for consideration and discussion of comments and complaints from the public. Those wishing to address the Commission shall request permission in advance by filling out a speaker slip. Action taken as a result of public comment will be limited to directing staff to study the matter or rescheduling the matter for further consideration and decision at a later date unless it is the subject of an item already on the agenda.

NOTE: The Commission may hold additional public comment periods throughout these regular and resumed public meetings on the call of the Chairman as necessary and appropriate to accommodate the public.

- III. Presentation by NDC, discussion and possible decision(s) concerning the results of the testing of the Flagstaff A and B proposals.
- IV. Presentation by NDC, discussion and possible decision(s) concerning possible changes to the legislative plan for population balancing, including the impact of those changes on competitiveness and the other constitutional redistricting criteria.
- V. Presentation by legal counsel, discussion and possible decision(s) concerning reports from consultants.
- VI. Discussion and possible decision concerning adoption of a final, permanent legislative redistricting plan.
- VII. Certification of final, permanent legislative districts to the Secretary of State.
- VIII. Report of Executive Director.
- IX. Instructions to staff and legal counsel.
- X. Discussion of future Commission Meeting(s).
- XI. Recess or Adjournment.
