IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission's (AIRC) revised plan certified to the Secretary of State on May 28, 2002 (Exhibit 496) ("AIRC Plan") shall be used on an emergency interim basis in the 2002 Arizona legislative primary and general elections.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the members of the Arizona Legislature elected in 2002 pursuant to the emergency interim AIRC Plan shall serve for the full two-year term beginning in January 2003.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Counties' Motion for Emergency Interim Relief for the Conduct of the 2002 Elections is granted. A legal opinion will be forthcoming in the next few weeks.
