

NOTE: All matters on the agenda maybe presented, discussed and are subject to possible decision by the Commission in person or electronically.

The agenda is as follows:

- II. Presentation by NDC, discussion and possible decision(s) concerning possible changes to the final legislative plan for neighborhood clean-up and/or to correct small population traps between congressional and legislative lines.
